## **Towards A European Certification Scheme for Security Products, Systems and Services**

### **A Workshop on the CRISP Certification Process and Methodology**

**Background:** CRISP (Evaluation and Certification Schemes for Security Products) is a three year project (April 2014 – March 2017) that aims to facilitate a harmonised playing field for the European security industry by developing a robust methodology for security Products, Systems and Services (PSS) certification. CRISP will enhance existing security evaluation and certification schemes by offering an innovative evaluation methodology that integrates security, trust, efficiency and freedom infringement assessment dimensions. The proposed scheme will be based on a taxonomy encompassing a variety of security products and services across applications, taking into account the varying roles of a diverse stakeholder community including manufacturers, regulatory and certification bodies, data protection authorities and end users.

**Aims of the workshop:** Inviting a range of stakeholders, this CRISP workshop aims to present and discuss the developed CRISP certification methodology for security PSS. The workshop will also seek to summarise requirements for a clear roadmap for the proposed CRISP certification scheme and certification manual.

The workshop is aimed at both supply and demand side of security products, systems and services, as well as regulators, policy makers and civil society representatives.

**The Venue:** The workshop is organised by the Technische Universität Berlin and will be held at the Center for Technology and Society in Berlin, Germany.
